## 2. APPROVAL OF 5/16/22 MEETING MINUTES

#### 4. **DISCUSSION ITEMS**

#### A. Traffic Count Locations

Alec Miller explained that the MACC is seeking member input as to where the FY22 traffic count locations should be. Howard Fink suggested that if any members had a desired spot, then they would send them to the MACC. The MACC would then select the best locations and recommend them at the next meeting.

#### B. <u>Request for Proposals – I-196 Business Loop Crossing Study</u>

Alec Miller explained that there recently was a meeting to discuss doing a crossing study on I-196 Business Loop. The goal of this would be to find the best location for crossings and the best type of pedestrian crossings. An RFP was created by ODC and the MACC was asking for reviewal/comment. As of now, it's suspected to be a \$100,000 project, with \$80,000 coming from the FY23 STP. It was decided that no vote was needed to approve the RFP and that the MACC could simply move it forward to Policy.

Howard Fink made a **MOTION** to approve amending the FY23 UWP to include a new section regarding the I-196 BL Crossing Study. **SUPPORTED** by Steve Bulthuis. **MOTION PASSED**.
