On June 6, 2022, the MACC Policy Board approved the FY2023 - 2026 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The TIP leverages **\$652,000** of member contributions over a four-year period to receive over **\$74.9 million** in transportation infrastructure improvements for our area. The MACC worked closely with member agencies to develop the TIP.

The project was funded by a portion of the \$196 million in federal COVID relief funds received by Michigan.
