


Spotlight on Tom Bird



Long Range Transportation Plan



The MACC is working on updating its Long Range Transportation Plan. We are required to update the plan every four years. This document plans transportation needs for our area's growth until 2050. The Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) is the statement of the ways the region plans to invest in the transportation system. The plan includes strategies and actions that lead to the development of an integrated intermodal transportation system that facilitates the efficient movement of people and goods. The MACC's Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) is developed with

input from community stakeholders, the general public, the MACC Transportation Technical Committee, MDOT, and MACC staff. The MACC through its stakeholder list makes special efforts to engage traditionally underserved as well as other interested parties in the development of the plan.

BL I-196 Public Meeting



The MACC is hosting a public meeting regarding their I-196 Business Loop [Chicago Drive] Pedestrian Crossing Study. This will be a joint meeting with MDOT, who will be discussing their I-196 Business Loop Road Rehabilitation Project. The study will develop a transportation strategy that allows non-motorized traffic to access the Macatawa River Greenway Trail (MRGT) along with other regional pathways, parks, and business districts.

The MRGT is a regionally significant trail system that connects Lake Michigan to points east of Zeeland. The purpose of the study is to determine the best locations for regional trail systems crossing the I-196 BL. MACC staff is seeking the public's input as to where pedestrian crossings are the most critical and what type of crossings are needed.

The meeting will take place Wednesday, March 1 from 5:00 PM to 7:00 PM at the Howard Miller Public Library Banquet Room, located at 14 South Church Street in Zeeland. Public comment is critical to successful determination of crossing locations and types.
