

Significant roadway, nonmotorized, transit and planning projects/activities contained in the MACC's Transportation Improvement Plan for fiscal year 2006. It is anticipated that all these projects will be constructed this year.

River Avenue Bridge (@ Macatawa River)

A six-lane vehicular bridge as well as a pedestrian bridge to the west of the vehicular bridge will be constructed. \$1,834,00 in federal funds was programmed for these projects.

Lakewood Boulevard (@ 144th Avenue)

This intersection will be reconstructed to provide center lanes for left turns on each approach. This project is utilizing \$164,000 in federal funds.

River Avenue (15th-Macatawa River)

The roadway will be reconstructed with the assistance of \$928,000 in federal High Priority Project funds designated for River Avenue corridor improvements.

96th Avenue (Woodbridge-Adams)

A nonmotorized path will be constructed along this section of 96th Avenue. \$58,000 in federal funds has been allocated to this job.

I-196 Business Loop (96th Avenue-I 196)

This 2.3 mile section of state roadway will be reconstructed utilizing \$3,119,200 in federal funds.

US 31 Bridge (over CSX rail line)

The bridge over the railroad line on US 31 (next to the Macatawa River) will be receiving some substructure repairs. The project is receiving \$367,067 in federal funds.
