

CEP 2022 Summary



The Community Enhancement Program (CEP) is a MACC-administered program that allocates small grants to support regional projects that "bring us all together." The CEP is made up of five MACC members: Laketown Township, Zeeland Charter Township, Holland Charter Township, the City of Zeeland, and the City of Holland. The CEP issued grants to the Boys and Girls Club for summer migrant programs, the Holland Symphony for a mariachi concert, Momentum for a van to help transport community members with mental illness or disabilities, the Park Theater for attic insulation and wiring, and the Holland Chorale for community high school concerts. The CEP granted over \$24,000 in awards in 2022.
