RE: POST-CONSTRUCTION STORMWATER RUNOFF REQUIREMENTS FOR ALLEGAN COUNTY ROAD COMMISSION PROJECTS

To Whom It May Concern,

The Allegan County Road Commission (ACRC) is subject to the regulatory requirements of the US Environmental Protection Agency's Phase II Municipal Stormwater Program, administered by the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes and Energy. The current permit for the ACRC under this program took effect on August 1, 2022.

One of the regulatory requirements is to implement and enforce a program to address post-construction storm water runoff from new development and re-development projects that disturb one or more acres of soil and discharge into the permittee's storm sewer system within the regulated area of Allegan County. The permit also requires that all projects meet a specific water quality treatment and channel protection performance standards.

The ACRC will defer to and follow the approved Allegan County Drain Commission Post-Construction Storm Water Runoff Program requirements for projects that occur on ACRC property or rights of ways within the regulated area of Allegan County.
