This \$3.863 million dollar project kicked off this spring, and is scheduled to be completed in November of 2023, although work is progressing faster than anticipated. This project was selected from the MACC's Transportation Improvement Program (TIP).

The MACC will be using the e-bikes to rate the entire non-motorized network (bike paths, shared use paths, and paved shoulders), to update our Non-Motorized Plan in 2024, conduct safety audits, and to attend local meetings, when weather permits.
